With the recent difficulties faced by travelers coming to Nigeria while filling their health and travel history on the Nigerian International Travel Portal (NITP), airlines have now been instructed to allow the following travelers to board:

- travelers who are unable to pay or repeat day 7 covid-19 PCR test
- travelers who are unable to generate the paid QR code / permit to fly
- holders of diplomatic passports
- children aged ten(10) years and below who are unable to complete the NITP

The above travelers can now make payment for their Covid -19 PCR test at their destination airport while children below the age of ten (10)years will have their health declaration and travel history captured by the port health services (PHS) at the destination airport. Airlines are to ensure strict compliance with the above stated conditions.
